Winter 2009 Runway Closures for Essential Maintenance Work

I am writing to advise you of the annual programme and nature of night time works, which have been identified as being essential during November 2009.

The runway closures are restricted to nine dates within November, in order that the pre-planned maintenance works can be undertaken, these being:

Tuesday 10 th November	closure 2300 - 0600 hrs
Wednesday 11 th November	closure 2300 - 0600 hrs
Thursday 12 th November	closure 2300 - 0600 hrs
Tuesday 17 th November	closure 2300 - 0600 hrs
Wednesday 18 th November	closure 2300 - 0600 hrs
Thursday 19 th November	closure 2300 - 0600 hrs
Tuesday 24 th November	closure 2300 – 0600 hrs
Wednesday 25 th November	closure 2300 – 0600 hrs
Thursday 26 th November	closure 2300 – 0600 hrs


All closures are subject to suitable weather conditions. Alternative dates may be required if inclement weather is experienced on one or more of the above dates.

Surface repair works will take place on Runways and Taxiways and will include the breaking out of defective concrete. This work will take place at the beginning of each closure period, with the aim of completion before midnight, after which the pouring and curing of concrete will take place.

The Airport Company is very much aware that night time works have the potential to cause nuisance to our neighbours. However, every effort will be made to ensure that any impacts are reduced to a minimum. In addition, the works will be supervised by the Airport Company, to ensure that all the agreed constraints on the contractors are complied with.
